# Community Health Impact Council (CHIC) Highlights

CHIC invests in innovative community health programs benefiting our most vulnerable neighbors

## Hospital to Medical Home Community Health Centers

This program navigates, monitors and ensures continuity of care for high-risk patients by placing a designated patient advocate at the hospital for those in need of a medical home.

INVESTMENT:

## Hope Clinic Adventist University of Health Sciences (ADU)

This program provides uninsured and underserved patients with physical therapy, physician assistant and nursing services using licensed and student practitioners from ADU.

INVESTMENT:  
**\$564,550**

## Community Paramedics Health Council of East Central Florida

Working alongside the Florida Department of Health in Seminole County, this program delivers follow-up care provided by a paramedic to high-risk patients who have recently visited the hospital.

## Chronic Disease Self- Management Program Center for Change

These community-led workshops demonstrate to people with chronic health problems how to manage their health while maintaining active and fulfilling lives.

## Community Outreach Food Co-Op Mt. Sinai Seventh-day Adventist Church

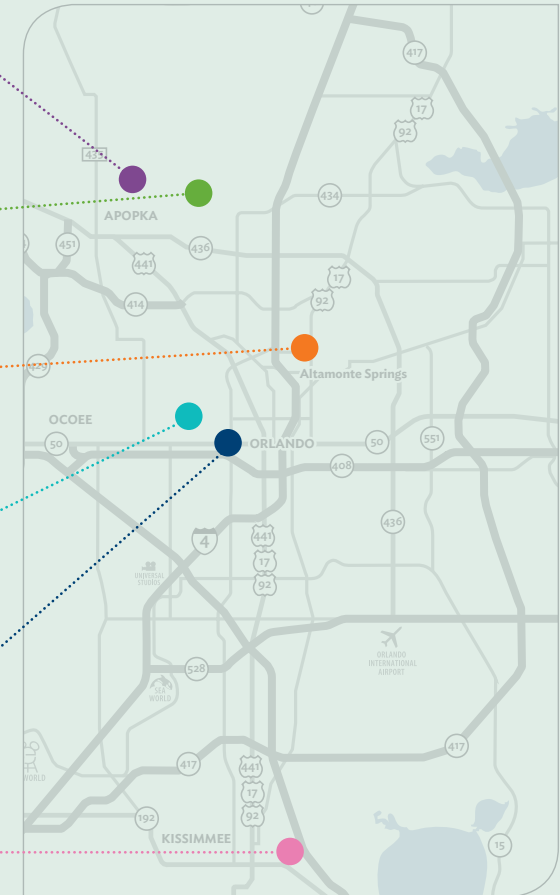
This food cooperative delivers 75,000 pounds of fresh produce per week to 14 organizations across our community.
